Automatically awarded upon MSU admission based on 9th-11th grade high school GPA and/or test scores. GPA is based upon a 4.0 scale.

FRESHMAN ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NON-RESIDENTS

The ACT superscore accepted by MSU is the 3-part superscore, which excludes the Science section of the ACT.

Students with a 34+ ACT/SAT equivalent score will receive a one-year, on-campus housing scholarship valued at the cost of their portion of a double occupancy room.

Please note the scholarship amounts listed could be a combination of institutional scholarships/aid and/or private awards.

2027-2028 Freshman Academic Scholarships are renewed annually (fall semester and spring semester) up to 8 semesters based on overall MSU GPA.

To be considered for competitive scholarships that could stack with the Freshman Non-Resident Scholarships, admitted students can submit the General Scholarship Application (GSA) beginning October 1, 2026, at my.msstate.edu. The priority date for maximum consideration is December 1, 2026.
