Under Federal law your family is primarily responsible for paying for your college expenses. In **very** limited situations Federal law may allow us to consider a dependent student as independent (for financial aid purposes) when unusual conditions exist. Please note: ****Appeals cannot be processed until we receive ALL requested documents.**

Examples of unusual conditions where you may be unable to provide parental data include:

- Your parents are incarcerated; or
- You have left home due to an abusive family environment; or
- You do not know your parents location, are unable to contact them, and you are not adopted.

Not all situations are considered unusual. The following would not be considered valid situations:

- You do not live with your parents, or you are self-sufficient; or
- Your parents refuse to contribute to your college expenses; or
- Your parents do not claim you (the student) as an exemption on their income taxes.

****Verification of your FAFSA information must be completed before adjustments can be made. Regularly check your Eligibility Requirements on your MSU myState and your MSU email address to see documents requested and/or if you need to submit additional documentation. Not submitting ALL documents listed will delay your appeal.**

New Appeals	Provide both Section A and Section B documentation listed.
Updating Prior Appeals	Provide both Section A and Section C documentation listed. Prior appeals are those that we approved for you in the previous award year.

Section A – Required Documentation for New and Updated Dependency Override Appeals:	
1. 2023-2024 MSU Dependency Override Form	Download and complete requested 2023-2024 forms at https://www.sfa.msstate.edu/forms/ Forms must be SIGNED and completed
2. 2023-2024 MSU Household Size/College Verification Form	
3. Student signed statement	Detail your appeal reason Include specific details and dates situation occurred
4. 2021 Tax Information (filers & nonfilers)– request at https://www.irs.gov/ :	
2021 Tax Filers Required if you DID file	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy of all Schedules filed (1, 2, 3, A, C, D, K-1) AND • Signed 2021 IRS Federal 1040 Tax Return; OR • 2021 IRS Federal Tax Return Transcript
2021 Nontax Filers Required if you did NOT file	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request a 2021 IRS Verification of Non-Filing Letter and provide us with a copy; AND • Signed 2023-2024 MSU Independent Student Nontax Filer Form; AND • Copies of all 2021 W-2 Forms and/or 1099 Forms

Section B – Required Additional Documentation for New Appeals only:

- ❖ Death of One parent or Custodial parent, and no contact with non-custodial parent; OR
- ❖ You no longer live with your parents due to unsafe home environment (i.e. – physical, emotional, drug, or alcohol abuse); OR
- ❖ You no longer live with your parents due to abandonment, incarceration, estrangement or mental incapacity

1. Copy of death certificate or full obituary

2. Copy of student's birth certificate

3. **Minimum** of two detail, **signed** letters (professional and/or personal):

Professional References

- **Signed**, dated, and listed on agency letterhead
- Law enforcement, guidance counselor, social worker, clergy, teacher, etc.

Personal References:

- **Signed, dated, and notarized**
- Explaining how they know you and for how long they have known you
- Explaining how they know about your situation

Section C – Required Documentation to UPDATE Prior Appeals only:

1. **Section A documents** (including new 2324 Dependency Override Appeal form)
2. Student **signed** statement **updating** us on the nature of your situation for which we approved the appeal
 - a. Indicate the **current status as of today** – (situation is unchanged, reconciliation has occurred, etc.)
 - b. You cannot use a previous student statement
